ROLY POLY

STEP 01

From each sheet of patterned paper, trim a 3.5×4 inch rectangle. You may want to use a tearing ruler on the top edge of some of these to give the rolls more dimension. If you do so, use the tearing ruler on the top edge before you trim the paper to size.

STEP 02

For each paper roll, do the following: Place adhesive along one of the 3.5 inch edges. On the opposite edge from the adhesive, begin rolling the paper. Keep rolling until you've reached the adhesive. Roll onto the adhesive, and run your finger along the edge gently to seal it.

STEP 03

Cut a sheet of 8×10.5 inch white cardstock. Using a corner rounder, punch the top left edge.

STEP 04

On the seam side of each paper roll, apply adhesive. Place the rolls on the bottom portion of the white cardstock. Gently press on the rolls with your fingers to secure. Wrap a length of twine around the rolls, tying on top of the rolls.







Use up those scraps of patterned paper to create this fun element on a layout or a card!

SUPPLIES

Patterned Paper: Studio Calico Memoir Collection; Chipboard: Studio CalicoTeal Chipboard Alpha; Mist: Mister Huey's Plumb Thumb; Rubons: Tweets Woodgrain; Stickers: Studio Calico Elementary Label Stickers; Punch: EK Success Heart Punch; Stapler: Tim Holtz Tiny Attacher; Other: Bakers Twine



STEP 05

Apply rub-on directly above one of the paper rolls. Print your journaling onto a piece of white cardstock. Trim to 5x7, with the journaling going down the right side. Adhere 4 x 6 inch photo to this piece of cardstock.

STEP 06

Using Mister Huey, spray white cardstock. Let dry then punch out a heart. Staple the negative image to your page.

STEP 07

Place sticker directly onto left side of photo. Add your title at the top. Adhere the 8 x 10.5 sheet of cardstock to kraft cardstock.
