SIX MONTHS & CRAWLING

STEP 01

Cut 8 pieces of your selection of patterned paper to 2.75x3.5". If you'd like to stamp a piece of cardstock, choose a light color and cut to this size as well. Note: You only need 8 pieces because where the 9th would be placed, the peach cardstock will be placed in that area.

STEP 02


For the Alphabet & Grid backgrounds, stamp using versamark ink onto small piece of cardstock.

STEP 03

Sprinkle stamped area with Zing Powder, discard excess, then melt with heat tool.

STEP 04

Using the ink blending tool, press into ink pad, then onto stamped image rubbing ink in a circular motion. Add in other colors as desired.







SUPPLIES

Cardstock: American Crafts White, American Crafts Peach; Patterned Paper: Studio Calico Autumn Press Collection Pack; Mask: Studio Calico; Mist: Studio Calico Mister Huey's Calico Shine; Chipboard: Studio Calico Autumn Press Tags; Pen: American Crafts .03 Precision Pen; Stamps: Hero Arts for Studio Calico Alphabet Background Stamp, Hero Arts for Studio Calico Grid Background Stamp; Ink: Versamark Ink Pad; Embossing Powder: American Crafts White Zing!; Tool: Ranger Ink Blending Tool and Replacement Foam; Other: Buttons, Needle and Thread, Pigment Ink Pads



STEP 05

Arrange the 9 rectangles of patterned paper on the white cardstock and adhere.

STEP 06

In a separate area, place the "&" mask on the peach cardstock, then mist with Mister Huey's Calico Shine. Allow to dry then lift and mask will slide off.

STEP 07

Outline "&" with journaling pen to accentuate.

STEP 08

Adhere Peach Cardstock to grid background, then add photos & embellishments.
